The Supervisor of Elections office will begin reviewing vote by mail ballot signatures up to 50 days prior to Election Day and continue daily. Reasonable access will be granted following the submittal and acceptance of this request. You will be contacted once your request has been processed.

I request access to inspect ballot materials before canvassing or tabulation, including voter certificates on vote-by-mail envelopes, cure affidavits, corresponding comparison signatures, duplicate ballots, and corresponding originals.
