### **Canvassing Board Timeline:**

*The public is invited at all times to observe Canvassing Board meetings.*

*All canvassing board meetings will be conducted at the Supervisor of Elections Office at 830 W. 11th Street, Panama City.*

**Sample ballots will be published in the newspaper and online at [www.bayvotes.org](http://www.bayvotes.org) prior to the election.**

- April 8th 8:00 a.m. Wednesday Canvassing Board orientation meeting
- April 8th 8:30 a.m. Wednesday Public testing of all Municipal Election Equipment until complete (1 – 2 hours, Wed prior to EV)
- April 17th 8:30 a.m. Friday 4 days prior to Election begin Vote by Mail ballot processing with Municipal Canvassing Boards
- April 21st 1:00 p.m. Tuesday Vote by Mail processing/early voting and receipt/verification of Election Results until complete (Unofficial Results)
- April 24th 8:30 a.m. Friday Canvassing Board convenes to review/tabulate any accepted Provisional Ballots, and to certify Official Results

\*All Canvassing Board Timelines are subject to change and shall be stated and voted on at any canvassing board meeting, after the first meeting.

### **Voter Registration Deadline (F.S. 97.055)**

•Monday, March 23, 2020

\*ONLY registered eligible voters who reside in the municipality may vote in that municipality's election.
