DATE SIGNED (required):

Initially, each local officer/employee, state officer, and spacified state amployee must file within 30 days of the date of his or her appointment or of the beginning of amployment. Appointees who must be confirmed by the Senate must file pror to confirmedian, even if that is less than 30 days from the date of thoir appointment.

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Candidates for publicly-elected local office must file at the same time they file their qualifying papers.

Thereafter, local officers/employoos, state officers, and specified state employees are required to file by July 1st following each calendar year in which they hold their poeltions.

Finally, at the end of office or employment, each local officer/amployee, state officer, and spacified state employee is required to file a final disclosure form (Form IF) within 80 days of leaving office or employment.
